

From the desk of Patron.....

Dear Alumni,

Greetings from your alma mater. We have again faced the problem of second wave of Covid-19 and such pandemic has incurred huge loss for some of our beloved alumni. I pray to the almighty to rest their soul in heavenly peace. The corona time has altered our social and personal lives, and the major impact was on our economy. The positive part, however, the two doses of vaccine we have been fortunate to get and I hope that all of you might have taken advantage of it. This has reduced the severity of pandemic during this month (i.e. July, 2021). I wish you and your family the best of health and happiness.



In the first half of the year, we had one Alumni meet at Sumul dairy campus. Such type of meetings can enable us to strengthen our bond and build a family rapport. I urge you all to organize such events as much as you can, maybe through online mode also.

During this time, except for the initial period of 2.5 months of physical mode of teaching, we are teaching as well as conducting exams online for the rest of the time. This time the intermediate year students are being granted mass promotion to the next year as per the government guidelines. From 1st April, 2021 our college has became the constituent college of Kamdhenu University, Gandhinagar. Under such circumstances, the Undergraduate and Postgraduate students of our College will be awarded with degrees from Kamdhenu University.

At the college, this year 56 graduates have graduated and 26 post graduates will complete their studies by the end of July, 2021. This time due to pandemic about 12 Co-operative and private dairies/organizations have conducted 'campus interviews' at the college which includes prominent organizations such as GCMMF, Amulfed Dairy, IDMC, Banas, Sumul, Lactalis, etc. All the dairy/food plants who used to make their presence at the campus interview till last year did not make their presence at this recruitment drive this year, hence few students are yet to be placed. Nevertheless, such students will get placed soon. The average salary of the students ranged between INR 3.5 to 9.0 lakh per annum. Three of our students of the current pass out batch have secured admission at IIM and one student from this year and two from previous year secured admission at Rural Management Institutes. I congratulate all of them for keeping our SMC flag fluttering.

All of you, in whatsoever profession or place you are, your Alma mater feels proud and happy when you progress and shine. All our alumni are brand ambassadors of our Alma mater. We feel proud that SMC is reputed and a highly respected brand in the society because of the stepping stone you all have laid down.

In the month of March, 2021 we have launched two dairy products viz. 'Moringa butter milk' and 'Pickle flavoured Greek yoghurt' successfully, inaugurated by our newly appointed Vice Chancellor of AAU, Anand Dr. K.B. Kathiria.

I am sure, this difficult time will soon pass by and we will be able to lead our normal life. However, we need to take proper care of ourselves and our beloved ones to face the '3rd Wave' as anticipated.




