INTRODUCTION

Abstracts (up to 500 words) comprising of brief introduction, objective, methodology, salient findings and conclusion should be submitted only by e-mail to Dr. Subrota Hati at subrota.hati@kamdhenuuni.edu.in on or before 10th November, 2023.

The Abstract must be typed in Times New Roman (12 font size for the body, 14 font size for title) along with proper address of University/College/Industry and mentioning the corresponding author with e-mail address and mobile number. After review by the Technical committee, abstracts will be selected for Poster presentation and acceptance letter will be sent to the corresponding author, on approval. Best Posters will be awarded prizes. Registration in the Seminar is compulsory for submission of abstract.
